

Application for the 2018-2019 Rob Kling Social Informatics Fellowship

The Rob Kling Center for Social Informatics is pleased to announce the *Rob Kling Social Informatics Fellowship*. This fellowship of \$5,000 will be used to support a doctoral student who is pursuing research in Social Informatics and interested in conducting critical studies on the impact and consequences of computerization, the Internet, or digital media on individuals, organizations, or society. The winner of this year's fellowship will be announced by October 31, 2018. This award may be renewable for a second year.

Applicants must submit a brief statement (up to four pages) describing their research, complete this form, and attach a copy of their transcript, a CV, and two letters of reference. Preference will be given to students who have advanced to candidacy, although all doctoral students at Indiana University, Bloomington are encouraged to apply. In order to qualify, applicants must have submitted the FAFSA and have demonstrated a financial need. International applicants are able to apply and fill out the FAFSA.
